While predominately Chardonnay, the blend also includes Pinot Noir and Pinot Menuier, both of which contribute to this wine's blush color and lush palate with lively, persistent bubbles.

The extended aging on the lees of over 21 months adds complexity to palate. Generous flavors of brioche, Meyer lemon and pear are held together by bright acidity.

The unique dryness of Extra Brut make this sparkling wine easy to enjoy again either alone or with food.
